Standards of Conduct (further delineated in the student Handbook)

Faith Christian Academy has adopted the following standards which, it believes, are conducive to the environment that will best promote the spiritual welfare of the student. FCA therefore requests each student - whether at home, school, or elsewhere --

Refrain from swearing, indecent language (including body language), gambling, involvement in any type of music that does not meet the requirements of Philippians 4:8 (“whatever is true, whatever is honorable, whatever is just, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is commendable, if there is any excellence, if there is anything worthy of praise, think about these things.” ESV), and to refrain from smoking, drinking, the use of drugs (including the possession of drugs), and the use of tobacco.
2. Refrain from violence and damage against the physical property of this institution, any infraction of state or federal penal code, improper boy-girl relationships, and a critical and/or uncooperative attitude.
3. Maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, morality, and honesty. Students are expected to abide by these standards throughout their enrollment, whether at home, school, or elsewhere.
